




Bailey Bridge

- Easy to assemble modular bridge for spans up to 60m long, strong enough to carry tanks.
- Simple shaped, interchangeable steel parts.
- Small parts of the bridge could be easily carried by soldiers.
- Requires no special tools or heavy equipment to fabricate.
- President Eisenhower acclaimed it, after the War, as one of the three pieces of equipment that most contributed to victory in Europe.


